GENERAL PRINCIPLES AND EXAMPLES

Only outputs completed or started in the year the report relates are included (ongoing projects, for example, should not be considered).

The report should be written entirely in English. However, titles of publications, communications, or events originally in other languages, places of publication, etc., should not be translated (see below for examples).

When drawing up bibliographical references, we recommend that all the information is taken from the CV generated by the Ciência Vitae platform. In general, very few elements need to be changed, such as those indicated in colour. Copying from Ciência Vitae keeps the italics.
